Our role in processing your data

Why we are capturing your data

- Issuing notifications concerning technical and software updates
- Communications relevant to the service
- Training (as required)
- Helpdesk service.

Our legal basis for processing your data

We need a clear legal basis for capturing and processing your data. For this service this is:

- Contractual – SFG20 subscription contract and non-disclosure agreements when applicable for Consultancy work (SFG20 Solutions)

There is a legitimate interest in sharing your data within the BESA Group for the purposes of:

Who we share your data with

To enable us to deliver this service, your data may be shared with the following types of organisation:

Sending your data outside the EU / EEA

Personal data is not transferred to a third-party outside of the European Union or European Economic Area.

Our criteria for retaining your data

SFG20 provides a business-to-business service that sets standards for building maintenance. For the purposes of audit and to support / mitigate any future legal challenges, SFG20 will retain records indefinitely. However, we will minimise any non-essential personal data within that archive.

Consequences of not giving us your data

By not providing the required information, we may not be able to deliver the required service.

Your rights

At any point while we are in possession of or processing your personal data, you, the data subject, have the following rights:

- **Right of access**
You have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you.
- **Right of rectification**
You have a right to correct data that we hold about you that is inaccurate or incomplete.
- **Right to be forgotten**
In some circumstances you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records.
- **Right to restrict processing**
Where certain conditions apply to have a right to restrict the processing.
- **Right of portability**
You have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation.
- **Right to object**
You have the right to object to certain types of processing such as direct marketing.
- **Right to object to automated processing, including profiling**
You also have the right to object to the legal effects of automated processing or profiling.

Your consent

By consenting to this privacy notice you are giving us permission to process your personal data for the purposes identified. Where we are asking you for sensitive personal data we will always tell you why and how the information will be used. You may withdraw consent at any time.
